

## REMEMBER

- Do not enter restricted areas and do not approach, touch or feed any animals. Physical contact with Orangutans can not only spread diseases from you to them, but also from them to you. It also delays rehabilitation and can be dangerous. Approaching and touching macaques is also to be avoided, as they can be aggressive.
- Please take special precautions with your bags and valuables. The Orangutans and macaques are inquisitive and cheeky which can result in items being stolen and broken.
- Do not take repellants into the reserve as they are health hazard to the animals should they get hold of them.
- Do not damage or remove any animal or plant life. The reserve is a protected area, as are the plants and animals within it.


## GETTING TO THE CENTRE

The centre is situated on the east coast of Sabah, 23 km from Sandakan. Frequent daily flights or buses can easily reach Sandakan from Kota Kinabalu. The flight takes only 45 minutes and the bus takes approximately 5 hours. By bus you can be dropped off at the junction of 'Jalan Sepilok' which is 2.5 km walk from the Centre. Sepilok can be reached from Sandakan town by public bus (Batu 14) which leaves the bus terminal in front of the 'Nak Hotel', and ends its route at S.O.R.C.

The most convenient way to reach the centre when traveling from the airport is by taxi. Purchase a taxi coupon before you depart.
